ARI Pool Report Community Discussion:

Mayor Squibb:

- No Actions will be taken on the pool by Council at this time
- This meeting is an informational meeting on ARI's report and a discussion
- The full ARI report is available on the City of Hector website*
- The City is not able to Bond to build a new pool. Community fundraising is the only option. \$1.5 million will need to be raised before the Council will start the design, engineering, permitting, or procurement process.
- Grants for pools are only available to apply for at the end of the process, not the beginning of the process; the majority of the funds have to be raised first and have gone through the procurement process before you can apply for the DNR Parks Grant
- The price of a new pool will be around \$2.5 million or more
