1. Pool Report:

- Mayor Squibb stated he would be in favor of putting roughly \$24,000 that was left from the budget to go towards that bill.
- A Hector resident stated she would rather have a pool than have repairs done on the city streets.
- A pool manager is still needed on site to oversee the pool lifeguards.
- CM Ebbers advised the room that he hears daily complaints about the streets.
- Deputy Clerk Beckler will reach out to Moore Engineering to see if there is a technical writer to help assist with the RFP.
- Cindy Christopherson will prepare the grants and submit to City Hall for council approval.
