

## HECTOR CITY COUNCIL SPECIAL MEETING

Monday, April 27, 2020

6:00 pm.

(Remote meeting via Zoom)

Minutes

The meeting called to order at 6:06 pm by Mayor Weikle, followed by Roll Call.

Member present: Mayor Weikle, CM Heerdt, CM Hollan, CM Kandt

Members absent: CM Best

Others present: Administrator Aukrust, Deputy Clerk Beckler, Chief Pierce, Public Utilities and Ambulance Supervisor Rodmyre, Gina Schellenberg, Nancy Fosland and Michelle Melberg

### 1. Agenda and agenda additions

A motion by CM Heerdt, seconded by CM Hollan and unanimously carried, to approve the agenda as presented

### 2. Corn Chaff Days discussion:

- Administrator Aukrust sent out more information from public health to council members
- Governor Waltz is using a "Dial system" and said that any large community gatherings would not be allowed at this time
- Public Health said that there probably wouldn't be anything allowed in 2020 and perhaps not even in 2021
- Michelle Melberg stated nothing could be traditional at this point. It is hard to have everyone be 6-10 feet away and have enough masks and gloves for everyone
- Mayor Weikle stated the Hector Lions raffle would be live on Facebook
- Aukrust shared some ideas for CCD; we could do a reverse parade such as fire trucks, ambulance, etc. would stay parked, and to social distance, the community would drive around. Do fireworks that go along with music in conjunction with the radio station in Olivia, perhaps?
- Fosland suggested someone from Lions, FD, City, and Hector Community Spirit lead a "Modified" Corn Chaff Days
- Aukrust will discuss with Fosland of Hector Community Spirit on how to proceed with planning
- Aukrust will check with Public Health on food licensing for city celebrations

CM Kandt made a motion to "Modify" Corn Chaff Days, seconded by Hollan and unanimously carried.

3. Airport RFP lawn care discussion

- Contract out for \$25 an hours vs. city employees to doing lawncare
- Cares Act was passed; the city will receive \$30,000
- The city will use some of those funds for the city's cost share of the new lawnmower
- Funds can be used for debt service, wages, and utilities

A motion by Hollan, seconded by CM Kandt, to reject all bids and have city and seasonal employees do the airport lawncare.

4. Adjournment:

A motion by CM Heerdt, seconded by CM Kandt, unanimously carried, meeting adjourned at 6:30 pm.
