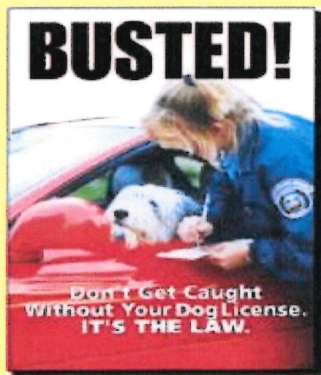


# SPRING NEWS 2025
