

**CITY OF HECTOR
WINTER PARKING NOTICE**

Hector residents need to remember that there are certain restrictions in regards to parking during the winter snow season. Please remember that NO motor vehicle shall be parked on any public street after a snowfall of TWO (2) or more inches until the street is plowed curb to curb, and no motor vehicle shall be parked on any public street for more than seventy-two (72) consecutive hours after a snowfall. A vehicle may be impounded without citation or prior notice if the vehicle is parked in violation of the City's snow emergency regulations. Any motor vehicle towed and impounded may be claimed and recovered from the City after payment to the City of \$95 for towing, \$10 per day for storage charges, and \$40 for the parking violation. The City DOES NOT ASSUME any responsibility for any damage done during towing and/or impoundment. If you have any questions on whether or not the streets will be plowed, your best bet is to have your vehicle off the street. Also, please remember that no person shall remove snow from private property and deposit the same on any public street or parking lot.

SIDEWALK SNOW REMOVAL NOTICE**

Please remember that the owner and the occupant of any property adjacent to a public sidewalk shall use diligence to keep such walk safe for pedestrians. No such owner or occupant shall allow snow to remain on the walk longer than 12 hours after its deposit thereon. The Public Works Department shall remove from all public sidewalks all snow as soon as possible beginning 12 hours after such matter has been deposited thereon or after the snow has ceased to fall. The Public Works Department shall keep a record showing the cost of such removal adjacent to each separate lot and parcel and shall deliver such information to the Administrator. The cost of removal of snow removed by the Public Works Department shall be charged against the owner of the property and, if not paid, the charge for such work will be made a special assessment against the property concerned.
